

## Scripture Calendar References:

Genesis 1:2 through 2:3 — the origin of the 7 day week, marks passage of day/night cycle by observing natural light

$360 \text{ day year}/7 = 51.428571429 \text{ weeks}$

$365.25 \text{ day year}/7 = 52.178571429 \text{ weeks}$

Genesis 8:22 — while earth remains, day and night shall not cease

Genesis 7:11 — the fountains of the deep were broken up 2nd month, 17th day

Genesis 7:24, 8:3-4 — the waters prevailed 150 days, the ark rested in the 7th month on the 17th day → 5 months of 30 days

Exodus 12:2-6, 13:4, 23:15, 34:18 — this month shall be your beginning of months, the first of the year, the month of Abib (the only month “named” in the Torah)

Numbers 20:29 — Aaron mourned 30 days

Deuteronomy 16:1 — Abib

Deuteronomy 21:13; 34:8 — mourn a full month, mourn Moses 30 days

Joshua 10:12-13 — the sun stood still for about a whole day (also prophetic? consider Lee Brainard’s comments on the two witnesses)

1 Kings 6:1, 37 — the month of Ziv is the 2nd month

1 Kings 6:38 — Bul is the 8th month

1 Kings 8:2 — Ethanim is the 7th month

2 Kings 20:8-11 — the shadow on the sundial backwards 10 degrees

Nehemiah 1:1 — the month of Chislev

Nehemiah 6:15 — finished wall on 25th day of Elul, in 52 days

Esther 1:4 — implies 180 days is half a year

Esther 2:16 — Tebeth is the 10th month

Esther 3:7; 8:12; c.9 throughout — in the first month (Nisan) [Babylonian and/or pre-Passover first month?), 12th month is Adar

Psalms 104:19 — He appointed the moon for seasons

Isaiah 13:10 — sun will be darkened

Ezekiel 1:1-3; 3:16; 8:1 - calculating the length of this particular year

Daniel 2:20-21 — God changes the times and the seasons

Daniel 7:25 — a time and times and half a time lines up with Revelation

Daniel 8:14 — 2300 days, then the sanctuary will be cleansed

Daniel 12:11-12 — 1290 days, 1335 days

Joel 2:31 — sun turned to darkness (opposite of Joshua!)

Zechariah 1:7 — Shebat is the 11th month

Zechariah 7:1 — Chislev is the 9th month

Matthew 24:29 — the sun will be darkened

Luke 23:44-45 — there was darkness over all the earth from about 6th hour to 9th hour

Acts 17:26 — and He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth, and has determined their pre-appointed times and the boundaries of their dwellings (so they should seek the Lord... though He is not far off)

2 Peter 3:8 — with the Lord one day is as a thousand years and a thousand years as one day

Revelation 6:12 — the sun became black, the moon became as blood

Revelation 11:2-3 — 42 months, 1260 days = 30 day months

Revelation 12:6, 14 — 1260 days = 3.5 years

Revelation 13:5 — mouth speaking blasphemies 42 months

*By a 365-day calendar, three and a half years would equal 1278 days. 360 day year x 3.5 years = 1260 days*

Websites for reference: (note, many websites can't seem to avoid "chronological snobbery" and simply assume that 1) the previous people just got the calendar wrong and 2) nothing ever happened to cause physical changes in the earth's rotation. This would seem contrary to recognizing the accuracy of the Bible in the things of which it speaks)

I want to add scriptures about planets being shaken (Isaiah 13:13, 24:19, Matthew 24:29, Mark 13:25, Luke 21:26, and earth being drunk (Isaiah 24:20) and sky rolled up like a scroll (Isaiah 34:4, Rev 6:14)[to roll down, to roll away, to roll together]

Additional thoughts: if the earth's rotation, and thus the calendar, did change around 700 BC, the change in day length would have been so small as to be initially unnoticeable. Also, since hours, etc, are measure by the earth's rotation on it's axis, there would not have been any change in that calculation, contrary to some claims I saw that the length of the year couldn't have changed because then there wouldn't be as many hours in a day.

Regarding the idea of a Biblical "prophetic year" and Sir Robert Anderson, I do not see any real Biblical basis for that. I think that if God told Daniel how many years and Jesus expected them to know the time, then it was easy to count years, not some mystical calculation that only certain people might discover. Plus, whenever dates are used in the Bible, including Revelation, they appear to be based on reality and actual experience.
